

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CRYSTLA LAKES, MISSOURI. AMENDING THE CITY OF CRYSTAL LAKES CODE OF ORDINANCES AND REPEALING ALL OTHER ORDINANCES REGARDING PAYMENT OF COURT COSTS.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF CRYSTAL LAKES, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 2. All Traffic Violations Bureau, Duties, Court Costs of the City of Crystal Lakes is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 3. All Court Costs – Filing Fees of the City of Crystal Lakes is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

- A. Total court costs will be assessed in the amount of \$34.50 on each case.
- B. The categories of fees are as follows:
 1. There shall be a fee of eleven dollars (\$11) charged from each municipal ticket for court cost. The municipal clerk shall be responsible for making monthly deposits of all monies to the City Clerk.
 2. There shall be a fee of seven dollars and fifty cents (\$7.50) charged from each municipal ticket for crime victim's compensation. The municipal clerk shall be responsible for transferring the monthly monies to the Department of Revenue at the rate of seven dollars and thirteen cents (\$7.13) for each municipal ticket. The remaining thirty-seven cents (\$0.37) for each municipal ticket transfers to the City Clerk.
 3. There shall be a fee of two dollars (\$2) charged from each municipal ticket for law enforcement training. The City shall use all funds received under this ordinance only to pay for the training required in Section 590.100, RSMo, et. seq. The municipal clerk shall not retain more than one thousand five hundred dollars (\$1,500) of such funds for each certified police officer. In the event that funds in excess of this amount are collected, the excess shall be turned into the general revenue fund of the City of Crystal Lakes, Missouri.
 4. There shall be a fee of one dollar (\$1) charged from each municipal ticket for Police Training. The municipal clerk shall transfer the monies following each court to the Department of Revenue.
 5. There shall be a fee of three dollars (\$3) charged from each municipal ticket for Sheriff's Retirement System. The municipal clerk shall transfer the monies following each court to Sheriff's Retirement System.
 6. There shall be a fee of two dollars (\$2) charged from each municipal ticket for Victims of Domestic Violence pursuant to RSMo 445.200 to 445.230.

Ordinance Amending Court Costs

7. There shall be a fee of fifty cents (\$.50) charged from each municipal ticket to be used for Appointed Counsel Fund. The appointed counsel fund shall be used to pay the reasonable fees approved by the court for the appointment of an attorney to represent any defendant found by the judge to be indigent and unable to pay for legal representation, and where the supreme court rules or the law prescribes such appointment. No municipal court shall retain more than five thousand dollars (\$5,000) in the Appointed Counsel Fund. Any excess funds shall be transmitted quarterly to the general revenue fund of the county of municipal treasury.

8. There shall be a fee of fifty cents (\$.50) charged from each municipal ticket to be used for Judicial Education Fund. The continuing education and certification required of the municipal judges by law or Supreme Court rule, and continuing education and training for the court administrator and clerks of the municipal court. No municipal court shall retain more than one thousand five-hundred dollars (\$1,500) in the judicial education fund for each judge, administrator, or clerk of the municipal court. Any excess funds shall be transmitted quarterly to the general revenue fund of the county municipal treasury.

9. There shall be a fee of seven dollars (\$7.00) charged from each municipal ticket to be used for Missouri Statewide Court Automation Fund as provided in Section 488.012.3 and such additional fee shall be collected by the Clerk of the Court and shall be transmitted monthly to the Missouri Department of Revenue to the credit of the Missouri Statewide Court Automaton Fund as provided in Section 488.027 RSMo.

Section 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.


This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
