

**UTILITY VEHICLE AND GOLF CARTS

Utility Task Vehicle – any motorized vehicle manufactured and used exclusively for off-highway use and is between fifty inches and sixty-seven inches in width, with an unladen dry weight of two thousand pounds or less, traveling on four or six wheels and equipped with a bench seat. Does Not pertain to riding mowers.

Golf Cart – a motor vehicle that is designed and manufactured for operation on a golf course for sporting or recreational purposes and that is not capable of exceeding speeds of twenty miles per hour. Golf carts are typically sixty (60) inches or less in width and travel on three (3), four (4) or more low-pressure tires.
